May 26 (Rain date 27)	Spring drive	This drive will leave from Carleton Place and will take a good back roads route to the 1,000 Islands viewing tower, via Forfar, Lyndhurst. Afterwards we will have lunch at a waterfront pub in Rockport before heading along the 1,000 Islands parkway to historic Homewood House. After this visit we take further back roads and county highways back to end the drive at The Swan on the Rideau and an optional post drive stop – distance and time are about 238km over 3hr 30 min in an 8 hr 45 min outing for a fairly leisurely pace. July 7 (Rain date 8)	Summer Drive	This day drive will feature the Ottawa River Valley on both the Ontario and Quebec sides, Pembroke, Fort Coulonge and Chutes Coulonge as well as Otter Lake, Quebec. The drive time and distance will be about 3 hr 30 min, 260 km in an 8 hour overall event, for a leisurely driving experience with several stops of interest. Lunch will either be a stop in Fort Coulonge or a picnic at Chutes Coulonge (to be decided). Details will be provided in the June Jottings and on the website.
July 14	All British Car Day ABCD	Britannia Beach. Details to follow
August 3-5	Weekend Tour	This three day trip focuses on the Muskokas area, the highlight being a 2 hour trip on a 19 th Century Steamship. We leave from Almonte, cross Algonquin Park with stops en route, before reaching our hotel for 2 nights in Bracebridge. On the second day we take a leisurely drive around Lakes Rosseau and Muskoka before arriving into Gravenhurst for lunch, an afternoon steamship cruise and a short scenic return to Bracebridge for dinner. The third day we head to Bobcaygeon to visit the Horseless Carriage Museum and the Kawartha Settler's Village before a quick lunch. After lunch we head to the Petroglyphs Provincial Park to visit the petroglyphs display, then head back to the Ottawa area, ending at an optional post drive dinner at The Old Mill at Ashton. Details of this drive have been released early by e-mail since accommodation must be booked early – space runs out in the Muskokas early for the summer season.
